DESCRIPTION

Key Areas of Responsibility

- Report directly to the Head of Visual Arts
- Attend school and faculty meetings as required
- Perform pastoral and playground duties as required

Key Areas of Responsibility (Teaching)

- Deliver direct teaching to groups and individual secondary students
- Implement BOS teaching programs in accordance with current syllabus
- Teach, set assessments and exams, and mark student's work
- Maintain appropriate records of assessment for reporting procedures
- Complete student reports

Key Areas of Responsibility (Students)

- Liaise with students as required
- Encourage and nurture, in a positive manner, the learning experiences of the students
- Support students through the College's pastoral care program
- Liaise with parents in matters regarding their child's progress

Key Areas of Responsibility (Other)

- Attend parent/teacher nights as required
- Attend performances and official College functions as required
- Participate in the College's Professional Development program
- Seek and participate in professional development opportunities relevant to the teaching area
- Carry out other duties as required by the Head of Visual Arts
