



Position: Teacher of Peripatetic Music

Reports to: The Head of Music Performance

Role:

To work with and support the Principal, Director of Performing Arts, and the Head of Music Performance in the day-to-day management of The McDonald College as well as the development of the ongoing mission and vision for the College.

Appointment:

Teachers of Peripatetic Music are engaged by the Principal in consultation with The Head of Music Performance. The appointee is responsible to the Principal through the Head of Music Performance.

<p style="text-align: center;">Management</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report directly to the Head of Music Performance. • Be a positive role model for the students in every aspect (appearance, attitude, conduct) • Actively promote the Peripatetic Music Program, Performing Arts Music Stream and Academic Music within the College and wider community • Inform the Head of Music Performance if their teaching times change or their inability to attend a student's lesson due to prior commitment • Endeavour to inspire an appreciation of Music in the student through their own professionalism • Actively encourage students to attain a performable standard of all repertoire studied • Peripatetic Instructors are responsible for keeping accurate records for the purposes of conducting their own billing • Finalise any monies owing to the College at the end of each term • Communicate with parents in both a positive and a constructive manner when they deem necessary whilst informing the Head of Music Performance of their action. The Head of Music Performance should deal with matters of some seriousness.
<p style="text-align: center;">Students</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encourage and nurture in a positive manner, the learning experiences of the students throughout their schooling. • Encourage students to develop the special talents they may have and support them in their performance areas as well as the academic areas. • Assist with the discipline policy by maintaining a consistent approach with students and by reminding them of the Code of Conduct of the College.

<p>Other</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Peripatetic Staff are required to encourage their students to participate in the Music Studio Recitals held each semester in the College's Recital Room.• All Peripatetic Staff are responsible for the invoicing and collection of their own fees. The College sets a maximum hourly rate that Peripatetic Staff can charge for lessons that is reviewed annually.
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
