

Secondary Mathematics Teacher

Full-time position, commencing Term 2, 2020.

An opportunity exists for a qualified, enthusiastic and experienced Mathematics teacher to teach in our Mathematics Department.

The successful applicant will be required to teach Mathematics Courses in Stages 4 – 6. Experience teaching Extension 1 would be favourable but not essential.

Applicants must possess a teaching qualification, have proven teaching experience and experience using computer applications in teaching. An interest in performing arts would be an advantage.

APPOINTMENT

The Secondary Mathematics Teacher is appointed by the Principal in consultation with the Head of Mathematics. The appointee is responsible to the Principal through the Head of Mathematics.

The position will attract a salary and teaching load as determined through discussion on appointment.

ROLE DESCRIPTION

Key Areas of Responsibility (Management)

- Report directly to the Head of Mathematics
- · Attend Mathematics Faculty meetings as required
- Attend Parent Information Evenings and/or Feedback Evenings as required
- Perform Wellbeing (Home Room) and playground duties as required

Key Areas of Responsibility (Teaching)

Teach NESA Curriculum classes as required



- Develop, update and implement NESA teaching programmes and assessment schedules in accordance with current syllabuses and in collaboration with faculty members
- Design effective assessment tasks and differentiate lessons to cater for a diverse range of learners
- Teach, assess and maintain records within the Mathematics programs as required
- Complete student reports and engage in conversation with faculty members on strategies to improve student learning outcomes using the report data

Key Areas of Responsibility (Students)

- Liaise with students as required
- Encourage and nurture, in a positive manner, the learning experiences of the students
- Support students through the College's Wellbeing program
- Liaise with parents in matters regarding the students' progress

Key Areas of Responsibility (Other)

- Attend performances and official College functions as required
- Participate in the College's Professional Development program
- Carry out other duties as required by the Principal

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Possess recognised NSW teaching qualifications including accreditation appropriate to experience
- Demonstrated ability to teach all levels Stages 4 6 NESA
 Mathematics Curriculum. Experience teaching Extension 1 would be favourable but not essential
